| Tables | Tables should be numbered consecutively and given a suitable caption and |
| | should be adequately embedded in the text. The table caption should be |
| | typed above the table, aligned to the left side of the table. Tables should |
| | keep within the margins. Large tables should be avoided. If there is a large |
| | volume of data to be presented, an attempt should be made to divide these |
| | over two or more tables. Each table should have a brief and |
| | self-explanatory title with Times (New) Roman letters, which are 10 point |
| | size. Column headings should be brief, but sufficiently explanatory. |
